Hello, my name is Karen, I am native British and I work at 'Fun English Language Centre' in Eching as a Teaching Assistant, which I consider to be a privilege.

The programme Suzanne has developed is very well thought out, and compares very favourably with other methods, being educational but fun and I am amazed at how the children absorb the English language.

It's very impressive and sometimes when I'm working with them they speak it so naturally that I forget this is a learning activity for them. The children are lovely and seem to enjoy themselves very much, and are very attached to Suzanne.

All the children I work with, from age 3 years to 10 years, can speak some English, they are so keen and enthusiastic – it's quite wonderful to see.

Some of the older children can even read and write English and as part of the programme are encouraged to keep folders, which is evidence, of their progress.

The Centre is a learning environment in which the children are safe and the process by which they learn is natural and nurturing.

This process is mixed in with lots of fun activities such as singing and dancing, and of course they have breakfast, snack and playtimes after they have done a session of learning.

As well as being fun it is also a structured environment as parents pay for English to be learnt and the children do need an element of discipline to help them focus otherwise, being children, they would play all day!

The advantages of children learning early English can be immeasurable in this global world and can only be good for the child when they start school and further into the future.
